PACKING LIST

TEAM PORTAL

Team Portal is an awesome tool that you can use to your advantage! To access it, go to globalventures.tv and find "team portal" at the top right-hand corner. Once you get there, you can:

1. Check your trip balance

See how much progress you've made!

2. Access your donor list

See who gave to your trip to reach out and thank them! Maybe even make a list of who to bring a gift back to ;)

PREPARE YOURSELF

(This is the most important of all the super important things.)

SUPER IMPORTANT PACKING LIST

(Paraguay Extended 2024)

Checked Suitcase cannot exceed 50 lbs.

Backpack 15 lbs.

Cash for Luggage fee (possibly \$40 each way)

Credit Card required for emergencies (Make sure card is set up for international use.)

Personal Cash \$50-\$100 for airport food and souvenirs (Bills should be 20's or larger and look brand new and free of any marks or rips)

Change of clothes packed in backpack in case your suitcase is delayed.

LUGGAGE

- ONE 50 lbs. suitcase
- ONE 15 lbs. backpack

CLOTHING

Footwear

- Comfortable walking shoes
- Flip-flops (for shower and hotel only)
- Nicer pair of shoes for crusades

Street Ministry

- 5-7 shirts (NO sleeveless, low-cut, or midriff shirts will be allowed)
- 3-6 pairs of jeans or capris (below the knee)
 - NO shorts, tights, yoga pants or excessively tight or holey jeans allowed outside of hotel.
 - Jeans for school presentations should not have holes.
 - Dresses & skirts are allowed as long as they follow the above modesty guidelines.
- Light Jacket or sweater (the nights will be cool)
- 1 pair of shorts and t-shirt for children's ministry
 - Modest shorts are allowed during training days
- Undergarments & socks (enough for 10-12 days)

Crusade Ministry

Men:

- 1 collared shirt
- 1 pair of nice pants

Women:

- 1 dress shirt or blouse
 - 1 pair of nice pants or skirt
- (You may bring a modest dress if preferred.)

DOCUMENTS

- Passport
- COVID-19 - No test or vaccine required
- Flight Itinerary (we will send this to you a few weeks before the trip)

MISCELLANEOUS

- Snacks (enough for your entire trip)
- Blanket and pillow for travel - if desired
- Bible, notebook, and pen (You may use your phone but internet may not always be good)
- 220-240 Voltage converter with adaptor plug (Scan the QR code here to find a great one on Amazon)
- Mini flashlight
- Sunscreen (at least SPF 30)
- Insect repellent (with DEET)
- Modest swimsuit and beach towel

TOILETRIES

- Towel and washcloth
- Soap and shampoo
- Multiple Kleenex travel packs or Toilet Paper
- Hand sanitizer and/or Antibacterial wipes
- Anti-diarrhea medicine

- Motion sickness medicine
- Pain relievers (Advil, Tylenol PM, etc.)
- Sleep aid (This is highly recommended and just short of being required. You'll need it due to time change/travel)
